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MATERIALS LIST

The success of the course is dependent on your participation:

- Complete beginning records of one patient including: mounted study casts, lateral
 cephalogram (oriented vertically if possible), panoramic x-ray, periapical x-rays (as
 needed), intraoral photographs, extraoral photographs including a smiling profile
 picture with hair away from the forehead and maxillary incisors bared.
- Tracing of the lateral cephalogram on clear acetate suitable for projection on an overhead projector (not on regular tracing acetate)
- Small cut-out rectangles of **clear** acetate (ca 6cm x 9cm) to position over the maxilla and mandible for tracing Element I incisor positions.
- Your Element I plastic template for tracing incisors.
- Red, black and green markers (Sparpee pens) suitable for drawing and writing on the acetate sheets.
- 3 page handout to distribute to each participating student (40 copies). Page one is
 the headfilm tracing, page two is for the patients intraoral and extraoral
 photographs, page three is the diagnostic sheet.
- Powerpoint presentation of the patients beginning records as well as diagnostic information and treatment plan (see included powerpoint slide layout example).

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
